

CODIFICATION CLAUSE

To ensure the process of codifying products that are defined by this codification clause and are subject to codification according to the principles of the NATO Codification System and the Unified Codification System, the Seller undertakes to:

1. Immediately after the conclusion of the contract, notify the Defense Standardization, Codification and Government Quality Assurance Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") according to § 14, paragraph 2) of Act No. 309/2000 Coll., on Defense Standardization, Codification, and Government Quality Assurance of Products and Services Intended for Ensuring the Defense of the State and on Amendments to the Trade Act, as amended, of the contract number, and possibly a copy of the contract in PDF format. The notification will be made via email to katalogizace@mo.gov.cz.
2. Ensure the preparation of the Asset Basic Information File (hereinafter referred to as "SZIM") and its submission within the deadline specified in the contract, electronically to the email address SZIM@mo.gov.cz and katalogizace@mo.gov.cz.
3. Provide as part of the SZIM:
 - a) a photograph realistically depicting the product in the form of an electronic file in JPG format, with a resolution of up to 1024x768 pixels;
 - b) a hyperlink to a webpage or an electronic file containing technical data about the product and the manufacturer. The electronic file must be in JPG format with a resolution of up to 1024x768 pixels, or in PDF format, with A4 page dimensions. In case a hyperlink or electronic file cannot be provided, verify the accuracy of the data necessary for the descriptive identification by other means;
 - c) The attached file must be a ZIP archive, in which the individual attachments are named according to the contract item number (e.g., 1.jpg). If there are multiple attachments for a single contract item, the order of the attachments must be separated by the "_" character (e.g., 1_1.jpg, 1_2.jpg). The name of the attached file must correspond to the contract number to which the file is being attached.
4. The Seller hereby agrees to the use of the provided photographic documentation for the purposes of the NATO Codification System and the Unified Codification System.
