CODIFICATION CLAUSE "B"

The electronic file must be in JPG format, resolution up to 1024x768 pixels, or in PDF format, in A4 page dimensions. If a hyperlink or electronic file cannot be provided, prove the accuracy of the data necessary for descriptive identification in another way.
- 4. The Seller hereby agrees to the use of the supplied photo documentation for the purposes of the NATO Codification System and the Unified Codification System.
